

Conditions of entry:

1. The event is open to all motorcycle classes, including side cars, manufactured before 31st December 1972 Historic Vehicle classification, however later machines will be considered at the organisers discretion motorcycle.contact@tymc.org.uk but will not qualify for any awards.
2. The event is open and membership of the TYMC is not a requirement.
3. All machines must be road legal and comply with the current Road Traffic regulations.
4. Entry fee will be £3.00 for TYMC members, £6.00 for non-members payable in advance.
5. Late entries on the day will be permitted providing the limit of 80 entrants has not been reached and will be charged at TYMC members £5.00, Non-members £8.00.

AWARDS: There will be five awards. Classes are:

Up to 250cc

Up to 500cc

Unlimited

Old timer award for machines up to and including 1950

Best TYMC entry.

Awards will be presented to the winners at the end of the event at Whitworth Hall and will be decided by a panel of judges comprising of the organiser and a guest(s). The organisers reserve the right to limit the numbers in each class and all entries will be dealt with on a first come first served basis.

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES IS: Friday 3rd June 2011

Starting times:

All entrants will be allocated a start time and given a number with their acceptance letter. It is important that the TYMC number is fixed to your machine as it assists in judging. Adjustment to start times on the day can be arranged with the agreement of the organiser and marshals.

All riders including late entries shall sign in on the day no later than 9.30am.

First bikes away will be 10.00am prompt.
