

## **24<sup>th</sup> Durham Dales Classic Motorcycle Run Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> June 2018**

Start & finish venue, **The Crown Inn Manfield, nr Darlington**

Welcome to the 24<sup>th</sup> running of the TYMC Durham Dales Motorcycle Run. The run takes place in two halves covering a total of around 100 miles. The route is split into a morning and afternoon session of roughly equal distance, setting off from the Crown Inn, Manfield, nr Darlington from around 10am. After a pre-arranged lunch stop of around an hour, where food will be available, the afternoon route will finish back at the Crown for a formal line-up of machines and presentation in front of the main building. The route is **not** marked but will be marshalled at the start, lunch and finish. **Please observe and follow instructions of the Marshals at all times.** Route sheets are provided. All organisers, marshals etc. are volunteer club members so please show them due regard for their efforts in enabling the run to take place.

Please note - This event is strictly **NON-Competitive** and is designed to be a friendly social run. Remember this is not a speed event and consideration is to be given at all times to other entrants and fellow road users. Also please show due respect to the owners of the start, lunch and finish venues and park up as instructed. **Please ensure that you have enough fuel** to complete the event as there is no guarantee it will be readily available on route.

### **Conditions of entry.**

- 1) The event is open to all classes of motorcycle (solo or combination) of any age. However, the emphasis is intended to be on those from the 'classic period'.
- 2) The event is 'open' and non-members may take part. Entry fee for TYMC members will be £7.00 and for non-members\* £10.00 (Please enclose this fee with your entry form). Note that a Buffet Lunch is included FOC in the entry fee.
- 3) All machines must be road legal and comply with the current Road Traffic Regulations.
- 4) Pre-booking is required, closing date for entries 20<sup>th</sup> May 2018.
- 5) All entrants will be issued with a starting number on the day. This number relates to your start time and will depend upon the type and capacity of machine ridden. Generally, older and smaller machines will get an earlier start time. It is important that this number is clearly displayed at the start and finish of the run to aid the organisers. First away start time is to be 10.15am prompt with riders leaving at approximately 30 second intervals. It is requested that entrants arrive early enough to enable signing on to take place. **Latest signing on time is to be 9.45am.**
- 6) Entrants are encouraged to take part in the formal display line-up of machines at the end of the run. This will allow for photographs to be taken and also for any presentations to be made. Any such presentations made are as a mark of appreciation to entrants for their participation and are not based upon any particular performance on the day.

The organisers reserve the right to limit the number and type of entries which will generally be dealt with on a first come first serve basis. The **CLOSING DATE for entries is 20<sup>th</sup> May 2018.** Any enquiries please contact the organiser Ian Tigwell 01642 700949 / 07761937508.
